WASHINGTON, D.C. - Congressman Jerry Moran today announced that Youth Pastor Clint Decker will be a Guest Chaplain in the U.S. House of Representatives. As a Guest Chaplain, Decker is to give the opening prayer before the House of Representatives begins their business day on Wednesday, June 4, 2003.

"I have worked with Clint for a number of years, and I'm excited to have him give the prayer before the House of Representatives," Moran said. "Clint has worked hard to minister to the youth of his area and be a role model for students. He will be an excellent representative for our state."

Decker is an ordained minister in the Wesleyan Church and is the Youth Pastor of the Clay Center Wesleyan Church. He is also involved with the Detour Youth Center as a board member, director, and youth speaker. Decker was recently married to State Representative Kathe Lloyd, who has one daughter and two grandchildren.

The prayer will be broadcast live as part of the U.S. House of Representatives' daily business on C-SPAN. It will air at approximately 9:00 a.m. Central Daylight Time.

While in Washington, D.C., Decker will have the chance to meet with House Chaplain Daniel Coughlin and Speaker of the House Dennis Hastert (R-IL).
