WASHINGTON, D.C. - Congressman Jerry Moran announced today that applications are still being accepted from young men and women interested in seeking nominations to the U.S. Air Force, Military, Naval, or Merchant Marine Academies. Students need to send their application forms to Congressman Moran, postmarked no later than October 1, 2003 for the next class, entering in June 2004.

Selections are based on SAT or ACT test scores, class rank, grade point average, school records, extracurricular activities, leadership potential, motivation, recommendations, and interview evaluations. Applications may be sent to:

Applicants must be legal residents of the state of Kansas, at least 17 years of age but not past their 23rd birthday on July 1 of the year of admission, citizens of the United States, unmarried, not pregnant and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents. The SAT or ACT exam must be taken and scores reported.
