WASHINGTON, D.C. - Congressman Jerry Moran today announced that Jennie Guttery of Alton has been promoted to serve as legislative director in his Congressional offices. Prior to the promotion, Guttery served as a legislative assistant.

"Jennie has been a great addition to the staff and has done an excellent job of serving Kansans," Moran said. "As legislative director, she will track legislation and work with Kansans to make sure that our interests are represented in Washington, D.C."

Guttery is a 1994 graduate of Osborne High School and a 1998 graduate of Cornell University in New York, with a Bachelor's Degree in Policy Analysis. She received her Masters of Science in International Social Policy and Planning from The London School of Economics in 1999 and her Juris Doctor from the University of Kansas School of Law in May 2002.

Guttery joined Moran's staff in 2003 as a legislative assistant. Prior to working for Moran, she worked for a national non-profit organization to promote transportation and highway safety legislation in Washington, D.C. Her interest in public service began with an internship for former U.S. Senator Nancy Kassebaum Baker. Guttery has also worked for State Senator Janis K. Lee, the U.S. International Trade Commission in Washington, D.C., the U.S. Attorney's Office in Kansas City and for the Kansas Attorney General's Office in Topeka.
