Moran Announces Additional Kansas Counties Receive Public Assistance Disaster Designation

Assistance Available for Tornado and Flood Damaged Counties

HUTCHINSON - Congressman Jerry Moran today received notification that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has added the following counties to receive Public Assistance for recovery efforts from the recent severe storms and flooding: Chase, Cherokee, Clay, Doniphan, Douglas, Harper, Kingman, Leavenworth, Lyon, Nemaha, Osborne, Reno, Rice, Riley, Saline, Shawnee and Washington Counties. The announcement comes on the heels of Moran's visit today to Reno County to view flood damage.

These counties have been designated to receive Public Assistance through FEMA. A Public Assistance declaration means state and local units of government will receive federal funds to repair or replace disaster-damaged public facilities and infrastructure.
